Lesson #1

Selamat (slam-at) = a general word used for wishing well, literally meaning to be safe.

Pagi (pa-gee) = Morning (until 11 a.m.)

Siang (see-ang) = Early afternoon (11 a.m. to 3 p.m.)

Sore (sor-ay) = Afternoon (3 p.m. to sunset)

Malam (ma-lam) = Evening (after dark)

Apa (a-pa) = What

Kabar (ka-bar) = News

Baik (by-eek) = Good

Ya (ya) = Yes

Tidak (tee-da') = No. (' indicates a gottal stop, similar to the stop in the middle of "oh-oh")

Senang (se-nang) = Happy

Saya (sigh-ah) = I, me or my

Anda (an-da) = You or your(s)

Siapa (see-a-pa) = Who

Nama (nam-a) = Name

Ketemu (ke-te-moo) = To meet

Sampai (sam-pie) = Until

Dengan (deng-an) = With

Terima kasih (tree-ma ka-seeh) = Thank you

Sama-sama (sam-a sam-a) = You're welcome

Juga (joo-ga) = too / also
