Hari Selasa (ha-ree se-la-sa) = Tuesday

Hari Rabu (ha-ree ra-boo) = Wednesday

Hari Kamis (ha-ree ka-meess) = Thursday

Hari Jumat (ha-ree Joom-at) = Friday

Hari Sabtu (ha-ree sab-too) = Saturday

Hari Minggu (ha-ree ming-goo) = Sunday

Months of the Year:

Januari (jan-oo-a-ree) = January

Februari (fe-broo-a-ree) = February

Maret (ma-ret) = March

April (a-preel) = April

Mei (may) = May

Juni (joo-nee) = June

Juli (joo-lee) = July

Augustus (ow-goos-toos) = August

September (sep-tem-ber) = September

Oktober (ok-to-ber) = October

November (no-vem-ber) = November
